Roll No 25-30→"Sphere"(log of wood,clay etc. could be used )
- b) Make a comparative analysis of any two dhabas or hotels by collecting data about them (Menu cards, eatables offered, rate list, tips for offering services etc.)
- c) Collect details(statistical data) in the file from any one of the latest cricket matches(eg.IPL) and then -  
1) Draw a line graph based on the changes in the run-rate.

  - d. Services being provided (clinically)
  - e. Procedure of getting admitted and maintenance of records
3. Prepare a report on Yamuna Action Plan. (500 words)

2. Bring a minimum of 10 used Indian postage stamps of any denomination.
