1. Visit a public place (e.g. a market, a mall, a cinema hall, a railway station, Fatehsagar etc.) during summer vacation and write its descriptive account

2. Read an English newspaper daily. Write five to six main headlines in a file, pick up a new word from them, write its meaning & use the word in sentences of your own in your English holiday homework copy for at least 30 days.
3. Write one page in a good handwriting daily in your English homework notebook from ORC. (Part-V)
4. Differentiate the following list of homophones. Give their meanings and use them in a sentence of your own.
 - a. birth / berth
 - b. ate / eight
 - c. die / dye
 - d. lesson / lessen
 - e. pain / pane
 - f. peace / piece
 - g. flower/ flour
 - h. check / cheque
 - i. dew / due
 - j. fate / fete

1. Make the following figures using a cardboard sheet (two for each).
 - a) Cuboid (in green colour)
 - b) Cube (in yellow colour)
 - c) Cone (in red colour)
 - d) Sphere (in blue colour)
2. Solve atleast five sums each of addition, subtraction, multiplication, division of five digit numbers as per schedule.
Monday – addition
Tuesday – subtraction
Wednesday – multiplication
Thursday - division
3. Observe the things you find in your surroundings and classify them into odd and even numbers e.g. a pair of shoes(2)- even, fingers in your hand(5)- odd etc. write down 10 such examples and draw and colour them.

Science

1. Draw any food chain of your choice on a chart.
2. Make a chart, as assigned roll number wise. Show how respiration takes place in.
 - a. Human beings (Roll No. 1 to 7)
 - b. Fish (Roll No. 8 to 16)
 - c. Earthworm (Roll No. 17 to 24)
3. a. Prepare a beautiful menu card listing a variety of food items (minimum 10) for dinner. Add one or two preserved food items in the list and against each food item write the name of the main nutrient the food item contains.

Or

- b. Sow a seed (chickpea, blackgram, wheat, maize etc.) in a pot, watch it growing. Click the picture of the growing plant after every 6 to 7 days. Paste these picture on a chart in their growing order and label the different stages of growth.

Note: - In case a camera is not available then do activity. (3-a) and rest of the students will do activity (3-b).

1. Make colourful greeting cards as assigned to you roll number wise.

Note: - Use only Ivory sheet for making cards.

2. Visit two public places of tourist attraction of your city. Note down the activities of the visitors, which according to you are contributing to increase in environmental pollution. Either capture their activities in your camera or draw the same. Write at least 5 suggestions which you will give them to keep the environment clean.
3. Select any profession and make a list of the fields of specializations in it (e.g. different types of doctors etc.) Now make a table with the specializations on the left hand side and name of at least one professional of Udaipur on the right hand side.
4. Read any newspaper daily for 15 days. Cut and paste at least three headlines that appeal to you the most. Give reasons to explain why you liked those headlines (25-30 words). You can stick the pictures related to them.

Creative Activities

1. Make a painting with poster, acrylics or water based colours on canvas, paper sheet or clay pots.
2. Bring a minimum of 10 used Indian postage stamps of any denomination.
3. Give at least 10 ideas or suggestions for each subject taught to your class to make your classes more interesting for you.
4. Develop a hobby and / or fine and/ or performing art. Come prepared to make a presentation of the same in school.
5. Write a postcard to your Principal at school address. Write it before 15 June 2009 and tell her what part of your holiday homework you have completed.
