English

Social Science:

History

1. Make two columns and distinguish between the following in the History copy.
 - a) Lives of kings and lives of ordinary people.
 - b) Manuscript and Inscriptions.
2. Draw different figures made by early men to represent particular alphabet from page no. 8 of the History book.

Civics

1. Draw/Paste the pictures and write the names of at least five different festivals celebrated by Indians, in the Civics copy. (Group A)
2. Draw/Paste pictures and write the names of at least five different kinds of 'food' eaten in India, in the Civics copy. Also name the state to which they belong. (Group B)

Geography
