2. Watch the TV commercials on any English channel and note down one jingle from each of the following product category :
Refrigerator, Washing Machine Soap, Motor Cycle and Car.

Analyse them in the following way

- a. Who is the most powerful person in the ad who takes decisions and is the leader?
 - b. What is the claim made by the product in the advertisement and how does it show itself superior to all the other products of different brands in the same category?
 - c. Ask your parents about how much their decision for buying the products is affected by TV. Make a Report in a file.
3. Collect samples of at least 10 tree leaves that grow in your locality. Keep them in a book for 7 days and then paste them in a file and give brief description of each tree in about 50 words.
 4. Visit a Museum (Maharana Pratap Memorial Museum, Ahaad Museum, Railway Training College museum, City Place Museum). Make a report on its sections of displays. Also get the data regarding the total number of visitors from January to December 2008.
 5. Make a collage to show the differences between the flora and fauna of the Amazon Basin and the Sahara Desert.
